Snow White Indian Hawthorne

Rhapiolepis 'Snow White'

- <u>Use:</u> A somewhat spreading dwarf shrub and will put on a show in early spring through summerwith clusters of white flowers. Snow White Hawthorn has vigorous growth with good branching to create a more uniform shrub than other Hawthorn cultivars.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full-part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Fairly drought tolerant. They do not like sprinklers, if you must use a sprinkler do so only in the morning. They prefer dry leaves.
- *Growth:* Grows 3' tall and 4' wide. May easily be kept shorter.
- Hardiness: 7-10, shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen New growth is red, maturing into a dark green color. Good leaf spot resistance.
- *Flower:* Small flowers are fragrant. White flowers in early spring through summer.
