

Clean Sweep™ Snowbank™ Indian Hawthorne



Rhaphiolepis Hybrid 'DB-01' PP32786

- **Use:** Snowbank is a disease resistant version of the popular, tough landscape staple, Indian Hawthorne. Dense mounding dark green foliage glows with attractive white flowers in the spring. Salt tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Fairly drought tolerant. They do not like sprinklers, if you must use a sprinkler do so only in the morning. They prefer dry leaves.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and 3-4' wide. May easily be kept shorter.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10, shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen Dark glossy green leaves have a bronze color in winter. Good leaf spot resistance.
- **Flower:** White fragrant flowers in early spring through summer. Blue berries fall-winter.
