

# La Vida Mas Indian Hawthorne

## *Rhaphiolepis indica* 'SMNRICS' (La Vida Mas)

- **Use:** Finally, an Indian hawthorn that blooms spring, summer, and fall! La Vida Más® raphiolepis was years in development, and it was selected not just for the sweet pink hue of its flowers, but its ability to rebloom and a useful, compact habit that expands the use of this long-time favorite for Southern gardens. Great for use as a foundation shrub or near the front of flowers beds to add evergreen color.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full (preferred)-part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Fairly drought tolerant. They do not like sprinklers, if you must use a sprinkler do so only in the morning. They prefer dry leaves.
- **Growth:** Grows 1-2' tall and 3-4' wide. May easily be kept shorter.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-10, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen Dark green evergreen foliage that is a lovely blushed peach color when newly emerged. Good leaf spot resistance.
- **Flower:** Lovely pink flower clusters which bloom on both old and new growth. Blooming non-stop throughout the spring, summer and fall with two times as many flowers as the species!
