

White Indian Hawthorne



Rhaphiolepis indica 'Alba'

- **Use:** A somewhat spreading shrub and will put on a show in early spring with clusters of white flowers. Compact growth make sit excellent to plant in front of the house as a foundation shrub.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 3-5' tall and 3-5' wide. May easily be kept shorter.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen New growth is red, maturing into a dark green color.
- **Flower:** Small flowers are fragrant. White flowers in early spring.
