## White Indian Hawthorne

## Rhapiolepsis indica 'Alba'

- <u>Use:</u> A somewhat spreading shrub and will put on a show in early spring with clusters of white flowers. Compact growth make sit excellent to plant in front of the house as a foundation shrub.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full-part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 3-5' tall and 3-5' wide. May easily be kept shorter.
- Hardiness: 5-9, shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen New growth is red, maturing into a dark green color.
- *Flower:* Small flowers are fragrant. White flowers in early spring.
