- <u>Use:</u> The Bloom 'N Again® Azaleas were developed by Mr. James Harris, a backyard breeder and hobbyist, with a keen eye for unique and unusual characteristics. These azaleas have been carefully selected for their repeat blooming habits and cold hardiness. The broad range of brilliant colors, flower shape and form make them desirable for any garden.
- <u>**Exposure/Soil**</u>: Prefer light shade and well-drained, slightly acidic soil, rich with organic matter. Dig hole two times the width of the container. If the soil appears too sandy or is heavy clay, amend with organic matter. Remove from the container and place in hole so that the top of the root ball is slightly above the ground level. Backfill. Water. Mulch. Keep moist until established.
- **<u>Growth</u>**: Moderate grower to 6 feet tall and 6 feet wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 7b-10; Shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen The lush, dense green foliage grows into a semiupright form.
- *Flower:* Has the same vivid coloring as the popular Formosa, but blooms spring and fall.
