## *Encore® Series*

- **Use:** One of our most popular varieties, Autumn Embers® deep orange-red blooms make a colorful statement in any landscape. Their low height makes them ideal for a foundation planting under your windows in front of the house.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Provide 4-6 hours of full sun (morning best), for best blooms, with some shade during the afternoon heat to protect from burning. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Feed twice a year with a slow release fertilizer. Prefers slightly acidic well drained soils.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3 feet tall and 3.5 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6b –10b; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen The lush, dense green foliage grows into a semi-upright form.
- **Flower:** Semi-double orange-red blossoms are 2.25” across. After the spring blooming period, these amazing azaleas begin growing new shoots and start blooming into full flower in mid-summer.
