Encore® Series

- **Use:** One of the most popular azaleas on the market. As a compact grower bearing huge quantities of flowers, especially in the summer and fall, Autumn Chiffon® works well in foundation plantings.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Provide 4-6 hours of full sun (morning best), for best blooms, with some shade during the afternoon heat to protect from burning. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Best on irrigation. Feed twice a year with a slow release fertilizer. Prefers slightly acidic well drained soils.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 2.5' feet tall and 3 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7a-10b; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen The lush, dense green foliage grows into a semi-upright form.
- **Flower:** This white and pink blooming azalea starts flowering in spring, followed by a summer bloom cycle, and fall bloom as well. Furthermore, the features a particularly sizable summer bloom period, somewhat atypical for reblooming azaleas. These blooms are medium-sized and traditionally measure around 2.75" across.
