Rhododendron 'Roseum Pink'

- **Use:** An upright, rounded, evergreen shrub with glossy, dark green foliage with a sensational mid-spring display of large, rounded trusses of clear pink flowers. Tolerates shade and thrives in cooler regions but benefits from protection from winter winds. Withstands heat and humidity. An excellent informal hedge or foundation plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun to shade. As with other azaleas, the partial shade of tall trees overhead is the ideal. It will adapt to full-sun sites, though. You just need to water it during times when it isn't raining enough. Grows best in moist, well-drained, organic soils with a pH range from 4.5 to 6.0. "Well-drained" is the key. Planting it in places that don't drain well is a sure death sentence.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 4-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Leaves are lance shaped, medium sized and light green.
- **Flower:** Clusters of pink trumpet shaped flowers with darker blotches in spring.
