**Finally, a low maintenance rose, but do be sure to keep them watered correctly in pots!**

## ***Rosa x 'At Last'***

- **Use:** It's the dawn of a new day for roses: At Last® combines all the romance of a fragrant, fully-petaled tea rose with the no-nonsense practicality of a disease-resistant landscape rose. No spraying is required to enjoy a non-stop display of large, sweetly perfumed sunset-orange blossoms from late spring through frost. Handsome, glossy foliage and a vigorous, rounded habit makes it ideal for use in the landscape or the flower garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 30-36" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Unsurpassed resistance to black spot leaf disease.
- **Flower:** Each cupped, double bloom is crowded with petals the color of honeyed apricot with hints of yellow at the center.
