Rosa 'Bloomables Sweet Mademoiselle' ('Meinostair' PP 28,659)

- **Use:** Bloomables roses come in a wide assortment of colors: orange, pink, purple, red, white, and yellow. These roses are time-tested varieties that offer exquisite fragrance and impressive bloom power. Types chosen based on disease resistance for the Southeast.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant your rose in fertile, well-drained soil and in an area with full sun exposure. Newly planted roses require regular watering until established. Water deeply when you plant it and whenever the top 3 inches of soil are dry to encourage deep roots.
- **Growth:** Grows 5' tall and 2-3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Disease resistant foliage.
- **Flower:** This variety displays excellent disease resistance for the type with large, full, double blooms that are unique in color. The color can vary with the temperatures, becoming lighter in the heat and deeper, more vibrant pink in cooler temperatures. The blooms are very fragrant. 35 petals. **American Rose Society Award.**
