

# Brigadoon Rose



## *Rosa 'Brigadoon'*

- **Use:** Award-Winning Color, Spicy Fragrance, and Garden Vigor. an All-American Rose Selections (AARS) Winner in 1992, the year it was introduced, Brigadoon, a classic hybrid tea, has blooms that only get better with age, not just aging gracefully, but maturing magnificently.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant your rose in fertile, well-drained soil and in an area with full sun exposure. Newly planted roses require regular watering until established. Water deeply when you plant it and whenever the top 3 inches of soil are dry to encourage deep roots.
- **Growth:** Grows 3-4' tall and 3-4' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Lush, semi-glossy, dark green foliage.
- **Flower:** Appearing in flushes throughout the season, long, pointed, ovoid buds expand into 5-inch, high-centered double blooms, endowed with up to 35 petals in vivid coral tones, which deepen in intensity over the long life of the flower, remaining beautiful long after others have faded. The flowers smell subtly spicy making it an especially nice cut flower.
