Rosa x 'Brindabella Pink Princess'

- **Use:** The Brindabella rose varieties set a new standard for shrub roses. Superior genetic resistance to fungal diseases such as black spot and powdery mildew reduce risk and the need for chemicals. A bushy growing habit with dense foliage and large, double fragrant flowers form the perfect combination of old fashioned familiarity with modern performance. Plant in beds or your favorite large patio pot. Available in seven spectacular varieties.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. All roses hate water on the leaves so try to avoid sprinklers and overhead watering if possible.
- **Growth:** Though very vigorous, this low maintenance rose grows to only 3-4 feet tall and wide in 2 years time. Very well suited to home gardens and commercial landscapes alike.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Unsurpassed resistance to black spot leaf disease.
- **Flower:** These bright pink roses give off a hard-to-resist fragrance that will make you want to “stop and smell the roses” whenever you get the chance.
