

# Desdemona Rose



## *Rosa 'Desdemona' PP30054*

- **Use:** Peachy pink buds open to beautiful, white, chalice-shaped blooms, with a pinkish hue. The incurved petals create an arresting interplay of light and shadow. The strong Old Rose fragrance has hints of almond blossom, cucumber and lemon zest. It forms a most attractive neat, rounded, bushy shrub. Named after the tragic heroine of Shakespeare's Othello. Its frequent blooming and pure white hue make it the ideal selection for both fragrant and visual delight.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off the leaves (no sprinklers/ don't water leaves.)
- **Growth:** Grows to 4' tall and 3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-11 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage is dark green and disease resistant.
- **Flower:** Peachy buds (with 50+ petals) open to beautiful white blooms with a pinkish hue. What sets this rose apart is its lovely fragrance. The strong Old Rose scent carries hints of almond blossom, cucumber, and lemon zest, making it a sensory delight. Excellent repeat bloomer.
