- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 18" tall and 3' wide.
- Hardiness: 5-10 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small, semi glossy, dark green leaves. Should be pruned back to 4" in late winter for best repeat performance year after year.
- **<u>Flower</u>**: Double apricot colored flowers begin flowering in spring and display a season-long show of color until early winter.
