Finally a low growing rose with strength and disease-resistance!

Rosa 'Meifranjin' (Blushing Drift)

- **Use:** Drift Roses are one of the most floriferous dwarf shrubs available. Ideal ground cover; It's pretty, tough, and disease-resistant! This compact, spreading groundcover is floriferous with clusters of large blooms on every branch. Will spread swiftly over slopes, banks and other hard to cover areas. Also looks great in containers on the patio with a little pruning.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Does not like overhead irrigation.
- **Growth:** Grows 1.5' tall and 3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-11 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Resistance to black spot leaf disease and powdery mildew as long as they are not overhead watered. Drifts should be pruned back to 4 inches in late winter for the best repeat performance.
- **Flower:** Displays attractive double, pink flower clusters with a warm, yellow center on from mid Spring to the first hard freeze of late Fall.
