Rosa "Meiggili" (Peach Drift)

- **Use:** Peach Drift® is one of the most floriferous dwarf shrubs available. Peach Drift® pairs well with existing perennials in any landscape. The disease resistance is exceptional. These repeat-bloomers naturally resist rust, mildew, Japanese beetles and especially black spot. A cross between full-size groundcover roses and miniatures, Drift Roses have a low, spreading habit that makes them perfect for container gardening, hanging baskets and rock gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 18" tall and 3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small, semi glossy, dark green leaves. Should be pruned back to 4" in late winter for best repeat performance year after year.
- **Flower:** Soft peach blooms cover the plant from mid Spring to the first hard freeze of late Fall.
