Rosa 'MEljocos' (Pink Drift)

- <u>Use</u>: These repeat-bloomers naturally resist rust, mildew, Japanese beetles and especially black spot. A cross between full-size groundcover roses and miniatures, Drift Roses have a low, spreading habit that makes them perfect for container gardening, hanging baskets and rock gardens.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full to part sun. They must have welldrained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **<u>Growth</u>**: Grows 18" tall and 3' wide.
- Hardiness: 5-10 Shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Small, semi glossy, dark green leaves. Should be pruned back to 4" in late winter for best repeat performance year after year.
- *Flower:* Deep pink flowers with a soft faded center bloom in abundance throughout the season.
