Gold Glow Rose



'Gold Glow' is a hybrid tea rose, meaning it is the classic rose with long pointed buds that opens to blossoms 5" in diameter. There is one blossom at the end of the stem. During spring, buds begin to open, revealing fragrant yellow roses that may bloom through fall.

Rosa 'Gold Glow'

- <u>Use</u>: Hybrid Teas produce large individual blooms on tall straight canes. They are ideal for cut flowers and make excellent showpieces in your garden or yard.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun. Plant your rose in fertile, well-drained soil. Newly planted roses require regular watering until established. Water deeply when you plant it and whenever the top 3 inches of soil are dry to encourage deep roots. Roses do not like sprinklers so use a soaker hose or water underneath leaves.
- Growth: Grows 4' tall and 3' wide.
- *Hardiness*: Zone 6-11 Shrub
- Foliage: Deciduous. Dark green foliage is disease resistant
 - Flower: The 4" flower appears gold when fist opening. Transitions to yellow lemon then cream starting at the outer petals. With a very full bloom and a 60-100+ petal count, Gold Glow rose is very fragrant and is a repeat bloomer.
