- <u>Use</u>: May be the best yellow Grandiflora of all time. It performs like a winner in all kinds of conditions with great vigor, fragrance, strength, color and disease resistance. It has everything to be a true champion in the garden.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full to part sun. Roses do not like water on foliage from sprinklers or garden hoses. They prefer well-drained soils so be sure to amend red clay and mound the flower beds if possible. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- *Growth*: Grows 3-6' tall and 3-4' wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 4a-8b; Shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Dark green foliage has unsurpassed resistance to black spot leaf disease.
- *Flower:* Medium sized flowers have about 30-45 petals and a strong fragrance. Golden-yellow, copper shading, ages to cream . Fruity, spice, tea fragrance.
