Rosa 'Golden Showers'

- <u>Use</u>: Golden Showers® is one of the most profuse blooming of all yellow Climbers. Her semi-double, 4" blooms of golden-yellow with ruffled petals blossom on an upright, continual blooming, and nearly thornless plant that is a great choice for pillars or obelisks.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off the leaves (no sprinklers/ don't water leaves.)
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 8-10' tall. It can be grown as a climber; trained against a wall, up a pillar or through an obelisk; or even grown as a tall hedge.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-10 Climber or Shrub
- Foliage: Deciduous. Foliage is dark green and disease resistant.
- Flower: Produces sprays of fragrant, double flowers that open Daffodil yellow and soften to primrose. Deadheading encourages continued bloom, but we stop removing spent flowers late in the season to allow development of colorful hips to end the gardening year.
