

White Climbing Rose



A strong and relatively disease resistant rose!

Rosa sp. 'Iceberg'

- **Use:** Bred in Germany and introduced in 1958, 'Iceberg' is one of the world's most popular floribundas. It is an excellent all-purpose rose great for cutting and landscaping. Its white flowers bloom continuously, it is vigorous enough to train as a climber. In hardiness, disease resistance, and abundance of bloom, they surpass hybrid teas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun (at least 6 hours afternoon sun). Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Roses hate water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 8-10' tall and wide
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Shiny green leaves.
- **Flower:** Fragrant white flowers spring to fall with pruning of old flowers.
