

Iceberg Rose Bush type



A strong and relatively disease resistant rose!

Rosa sp. 'Iceberg'

- **Use:** A popular shrub rose that has double white flowers, held in large clusters that are medium sized, open wide and then fall cleanly from the plant. The plant itself is a strong shrub that is bushy and well branched with smooth slender stems and glossy rich green foliage.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Roses hate water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3-4' tall and wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Glossy green foliage is one of the more leaf spot resistant types for the South.
- **Flower:** A profusion of fragrant white flowers spring to fall with pruning of old flowers. Summer-long, free-flowering blooms and vigorous growth.
