David Austin roses are prized for their unique combination of old rose charm (fragrance and flower shape) with the health and repeat-blooming qualities of modern roses, making them a gardener's favorite for their beauty, fragrance, and reliability.

Rosa 'Auspika' PP30924

- **Use:** A stunning deep pink that is sure to bring brightness to your garden. With a light to medium fragrance with hints of blackberry, raspberry, and cherry, James L. Austin has upright growing habits and a versatile shrub. Named for the son of David Austin Senior and brother of David Austin Junior.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun (6+ hours). They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off the leaves (no sprinklers/ don't water leaves.)
- **Growth:** Grows to 4' tall and 3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-11 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage is dark green and disease resistant.
- **Flower:** Bears large, many petalled, deep pink rosettes, each with a button eye. There is a light-medium strength fruity fragrance. Excellent repeat bloomer.
