

# Lady of Shalot Rose



## *Rosa 'Ausnyson' PP22171*

- **Use:** Rich orange-red buds open to chalice-shaped blooms, filled with loosely arranged, orange petals. The surrounding outer petals are salmon-pink with beautifully contrasting golden-yellow undersides. There is a pleasant, warm Tea fragrance, with hints of spiced apple and cloves. It quickly forms a bushy shrub with slightly arching stems and mid-green leaves, which have attractive, slightly bronzed tones when young. The name is taken from one of Alfred, Lord Tennyson's poems to commemorate the 200th anniversary of his birth. One of the top selling David Austin Roses
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off the leaves (no sprinklers/ don't water leaves.)
- **Growth:** Grows to 5' tall and 4' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-11 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage is dark green and disease resistant.
- **Flower:** Buds of vibrant, orange-red open to form chalice-shaped flowers filled with loosely arranged petals of salmon pink with a golden-yellow reverse. The flowers are deliciously fragrant with the scent of warm tea and hints of spiced apples and cloves. Excellent repeat flowering.

David Austin roses are prized for their unique combination of old rose charm (fragrance and flower shape) with the health and repeat-blooming qualities of modern roses, making them a gardener's favorite for their beauty, fragrance, and reliability.
