

Lemon Drift Groundcover Rose



Finally a low growing rose with strength and disease-resistance!

Rosa 'Lemon Drift'

- **Use:** Ideal ground cover; It's pretty, tough, and disease-resistant! This compact, spreading groundcover is floriferous with clusters of large blooms on every branch. Will spread swiftly over slopes, banks and other hard to cover areas. Also looks great in containers on the patio with a little pruning.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-24" tall and 2-2.5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Resistance to black spot leaf disease and powdery mildew as long as they are not overhead watered. Drifts should be pruned back to 4 inches in late winter for the best repeat performance.
- **Flower:** The Lemon Drift® rose Flowers from late spring until fall frosts.
