

Pilgrim Climbing Rose

David Austin roses are prized for their unique combination of old rose charm (fragrance and flower shape) with the health and repeat-blooming qualities of modern roses, making them a gardener's favorite for their beauty, fragrance, and reliability.

Rosa 'Auswalker'

- **Use:** This variety has particularly beautiful blooms. The buds open to reveal many petalled cups, which gradually form large, flat rosettes. The color is a very attractive shade of soft yellow, the petals paling prettily towards the edges. The flowers have a medium strength fragrance, which is a perfect balance of Tea and myrrh. It will quickly reach some height and still produce flowers and leaves lower down the plant. Named after the pilgrims in Chaucer's Canterbury Tales.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full preferred. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off the leaves (no sprinklers/ don't water leaves.)
- **Growth:** Grows to 8-12' tall and 4-5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-11, Shrub/Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage is dark green and disease resistant.
- **Flower:** An excellent, pure yellow rose that combines extremely strong and healthy growth with 4" blooms of 100+ delicate petals. The blossoms are quite large and evenly shaped, with many small petals opening to form a flat flower with a soft textured appearance. It makes an excellent cut flower for arrangements and his strong fragrance of tea and myrrh is a delight for the kitchen table. Excellent repeat flowering.
