- <u>Use:</u> After all these many years of worldwide propagation, a color mutation of the renowned Iceberg has finally occurred from the far reaches of Tasmania. The plant is exactly like its parent in every way but color—same great landscape value, same free flowering habit, same foliage, same flower form & showy clusters. It's just that the color has been kicked up a notch to a bright cerise pink painted onto cream. Color intensifies in cooler conditions.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Roses hate water on the leaves.
- Growth: Moderate grower to 2.5-5' tall and wide
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-9, Shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous; Glossy green foliage is one of the more leaf spot resistant types for the South.
- Flower: Medium, 4-inch diameter, in clusters of double pink and cream blossoms with color intensifying in cooler temps. Petal Count -18 to 24. Summer-long, free-flowering blooms and vigorous growth.
