His business prospered, and in 1918 it was relocated to Spar-rieshoop, Germany, where it remains to this day. Kordes® Roses are nat-urally disease resistant and healthy. They are carefully evaluated for such qualities as color, size, form, vase life, disease resistance, and fragrance. Heirloom Roses is proud to be a leading supplier of Kordes® Roses.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 2.5' tall and 1.5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The foliage is a healthy, shiny, medium green. Un-surpassed resistance to black spot leaf disease.
- **Flower:** Numerous, intensely plum-colored, double flowers are characteristic of this rose with a ight fragrance. The variety performs well in heat and humidity.
