David Austin roses are prized for their unique combination of old rose charm (fragrance and flower shape) with the health and repeat-blooming qualities of modern roses, making them a gardener's favorite for their beauty, fragrance, and reliability.

Rosa 'Ausowlish' PP29927

- **Use:** Soft orange-red buds open to medium-sized, cupped rosettes of perfect apricot coloring. They are extremely robust and have a lovely fruity Tea scent. Very healthy; it matures into an attractive, rounded, bushy shrub with few thorns. Named to mark the centenary of Roald Dahl's birth, with the approval of his wife, Licky Dahl – the colouring reminiscent of the eponymous peach in James and the Giant Peach.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full preferred. Tolerates some shade, needing only 6+ hours of direct sun to thrive. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off the leaves (no sprinklers/ don't water leaves.)
- **Growth:** Grows to 4' tall and 4' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-11, Shrub/Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage is dark green and disease resistant.
- **Flower:** The soft apricot and peach-colored English blooms are reminiscent of James and the Giant Peach and are continuously in bloom. Excellent repeat flowering. 55+ petals with a medium tea fragrance.
