
## Sevillana Rose



## Rosa 'Meigekanu' PP6384

- <u>Use</u>: Profusely blooming rose has trusses of fiery red, double blooms on an upright, bushy, disease-resistant shrub. The mildly fragrant blooms give way to bold hips in the fall. A great rose in the landscape or for use as a border or for planting in containers. Can also be grown up a small trellis or used as a groundcover rose.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off the leaves (no sprinklers/ don't water leaves.)
- **Growth**: Grows 3-5' tall and 3-4' wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-10 Shrub
- *Foliage*: Deciduous. Glossy green foliage known to have a good degree of disease resistance.
- <u>Flower:</u> An impressive display of bright red, semi-double flowers throughout the growing season. Moderately fragrant flowers give way to lovely rose hips that continue into the winter.
