- **Use:** Sunblaze® roses are miniature roses that are ideal for containers and gardens. Hardy and easy to grow, these compact roses bloom in bright, bold colors from spring until fall. Start your Sunblaze® rose off in a container, enjoy it all season, and then plant it into your garden in fall for years to come. Its attractive shape, heavy blooming and disease resistance for the Southeast make it a delightful **choice for containers and gardens**. Strong disease resistance with high tolerance toward cold and hot temperatures make Roxanne Veranda a good fit for all gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun. Plant your rose in fertile, well-drained soil. Newly planted roses require regular watering until established. Water deeply when you plant it and whenever the top 3 inches of soil are dry to encourage deep roots.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-18" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-11 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green foliage is disease resistant
- **Flower:** You'll love its informal, profusely open blooms that are covered in clusters of tiny flowers! Reaching only 2 inches across, these vigorous little Roses are compact, generous bloomers. The butterflies won't mind the smaller shrub and seek out its abundant nectar resources! Flowering from late spring until fall with some deadheading, the orange, red, and yellow flowers more than makes up for its size by pumping out the waves of flowers! Double (25-30 Petals) Light fragrance.

Perfect in a pretty container for your deck, patio, or three-season sunroom! Then watch it as it blooms its heart out! Keep this tiny shrub close to enjoying its scent and darling nature. The diminutive size of this Miniature Rose means it readily tucks into any landscape - even if you don't have one! Delightful balcony accents, cheerful additions to planters and porch pots in the sun, these cheery blossoms act as both thrillers and focal points.
