

# Sunset Horizon Rose



**Unique Flower Color • Great Disease Resistance • For Gardens of All Sizes** Sunset Horizon™ is an attractive Floribunda Rose with flower color that starts bright yellow and fades to deep pink/cherry red. Flower size is quite large when fully open. It has excellent disease resistance.

## *Rosa x Sunset Horizon'*

- **Use:** Sunset Horizon® flowers open vivid yellow with red petal edges and the color changes to deep pink and cherry red as the blossoms age. The heart of the flower remains yellow. This sensational rose bush creates a blooming extravaganza in the summer garden. The flower size is quite large, usually 3-3.5" wide, when the blossoms are fully open, and they have a slight fragrance. Rose Sunset Horizon® has excellent disease resistance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun(more disease issues in less sun). During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 3-4'tall and 3' wide. Prune in spring, removing old canes and dead or damaged wood and cutting back canes that cross each other. In warmer climates, the remaining canes can be cut back by one third. Apply a controlled release fertilizer in early spring. Plant in moist, well-drained soil in full sun.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Unsurpassed resistance to black spot leaf disease.
- **Flower:** Just like the colors of the sky can change as the sun dips below the horizon, so this rose will change color as it makes its home in your garden. the large blooms begin bright yellow suffused with red tones, especially toward the petal edges. As they open, the red color intensifies until it covers nearly the entire bloom.
