

Teasing Georgia® David Austin Rose



David Austin roses are prized for their unique combination of old rose charm (fragrance and flower shape) with the health and repeat-blooming qualities of modern

roses, making them a gardener's favorite for their beauty, fragrance, and reliability.

Rosa 'Ausbaker'

- **Use:** A beautiful climbing rose. The rosette blooms are a rich shade of yellow, the outer petals falling back and fading to palest yellow, providing a most pleasing two-tone effect. There is a lovely Tea Rose fragrance. Named for Mr. Ulrich Meyer, after his wife Georgia – both are German media personalities.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full preferred. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off the leaves (no sprinklers/ don't water leaves.)
- **Growth:** Grows to 12' tall and a medium climber.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-11, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage is dark green and disease resistant.
- **Flower:** Deep yellow rose with outer petals fading to a gentle, pale yellow for a two-tone effect. Her cupped, 4-5" flowers feature 110+ petals and emit a delightful and strong tea rose fragrance. Good repeat flowering.
