- <u>Use</u>: The large, old-fashioned blooms of this special rose harken back to an old cottage garden. Flowers are extremely fragrant with notes of anise and earthy pear. Its abundant petals are creamy white with an occasional light blush. It exhibits excellent disease resistance and is a wonderful rose for cut floral arrangements. Plant in a drift of 5 or more for an outstanding display in your garden and combine with salvias, echinacea, and grasses for a dreamy landscape.
- Exposure/Soil: Full sun. Plant your rose in fertile, well-drained soil. Newly planted roses require regular watering until established. Water deeply when you plant it and whenever the top 3 inches of soil are dry to encourage deep roots. Roses do not like sprinklers so use a soaker hose or water underneath leaves.
- **Growth**: Grows 6' tall and 2-3' wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-11 Shrub
- Foliage: Deciduous. Dark green foliage is disease resistant
- **Flower:** Large flowers have 100+ petals and are white sometimes suffused with light pink. Fresh pear scent.
