## Tottering-by-Gently Rose





David Austin roses are prized for their unique combination of old rose charm (fragrance and flower shape) with the health and repeat-blooming qualities of modern roses, making them a gardener's favorite for their beauty, fragrance, and reliability.

## Rosa 'Tottering-by-Gently' PP32074

- <u>Use</u>: Its beauty is found in the simplicity of its single yellow flowers and the spectacular display they create when viewed en masse. They are held in large, open sprays on a rounded, branching shrub. Named to celebrate the 25th anniversary of Annie Tempest's classic weekly cartoon which was firirstpublished in Country Life magazine in the UK in January 1993. The cartoon Tottering-by-Gently depicts the everyday capers of an English couple, Dicky and Daffy Tottering and their family whilst living at Tottering Hall. The tounge-in-cheek humor cleverly addresses differing social perspectives of our time.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off the leaves (no sprinklers/ don't water leaves.)
- Growth: Grows to 4' tall and wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-11 Shrub
- Foliage: Deciduous. Foliage is dark green and disease resistant.
- **Flower:** Charming single yellow flowers borne en masse. Light to medium musk fragrance. Excellent repeat flowering.
