The sunny color and its scent of maracuya fruits of Tropicana® let us dream of heavenly gardens of Brasil. Due to the very special flavor the flowers of this rose are perfect for creating rose jellies and rose desserts.

Rosa x 'Tropicana'

- **Use:** Tropicana carries a terrific reputation that still flourishes worldwide. Large shapely blossoms -illuminate the garden with warm colors and fruity fragrance. Big pointed buds are borne on long stems clothed with glossy green foliage. This classic hybrid tea rose introduced in 1960 is a very popular choice. Heat and humidity tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 3.5'-6' tall and 6' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green foliage. Very good disease resistance.
- **Flower:** Coral-orange large, fully double blooms have 30-35 petals well suited for cutting. Blooms continuously or in flushes throughout the growing season and have a very noticeable fruity fragrance.
