Wonderfully fragrant and quite long-lasting after cutting, Voodoo is a cut flower lover's dream. But this is one rose that does not need to be tucked away in the cutting garden. Tall and very well-branched, this shrub is clothed in glossy, leathery foliage

Rosa sp. 'Aromiclea'

- **Use:** This beauty will put a spell on you in no time, filling your garden with an unusually heavy production of unique, multi-colored, large 5-6" blooms of yellow, peach, salmon, apricot and red.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Roses hate water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 5' tall and 3-4' wide. Strong enough to stand up to summer heat, Requires pruning in the spring, to either 18 to 20 inches off the ground or half its height. Old canes, dead wood should be removed. Canes that cross should be cut backs. Remaining canes should be trimmed one-third in winter, and more in colder climates.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Glossy, dark green foliage.
- **Flower:** The multi-hued yellow, peach, salmon, apricot and red large blooms have 35+ petals and perfect, exhibition-style form. Add her to your cut garden for her coloring and be entranced by her luscious strong scent.
