

Bridal Veil/Vanhoutte Spirea



Spiraea × vanhouttei

- **Use:** Arching stems and blue-green foliage make for a handsome plant spring to frost. In spring clusters of white flowers decorate the cascading branches. An old favorite for borders and hedging. Widely adaptable and tolerant of mild drought when established. Excellent naturalized hedge. Deer resistant. Super tough!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Graceful, arching branches to 6 ft. tall, 8 ft. wide. Prune yearly to maintain fullness and shape.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone 4 -9** Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Blue-green leaves turn yellow in the fall.
- **Flower:** Clusters of bright white flowers cover the branches in the spring.
