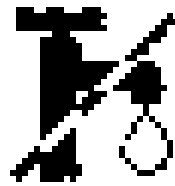


# Sprinkle of Sugar Spiraea



Sized beautifully for smaller gardens and spots at the front of the border, these rugged, carefree shrubs are a great choice for edging a border or adding seasonal color to foundation plantings.



## *Spiraea japonica* 'Sprinkle of Sugar'

- **Use:** The compact, white flowering spiraea with staying power, plus superior leaf spot resistance to keep it looking good through humid summers. Pollinators will be sweet on this one, but deer and pests won't be tempted.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 3-4' tall and wide. It naturally takes on a nice, rounded habit without pruning. If you wish, you can give it a trim after the flowers fade, which will encourage even more colorful new growth.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3–8; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Apple green foliage is a great foil for other plants even when not in bloom.
- **Flower:** Long-blooming white flowers attract pollinators
