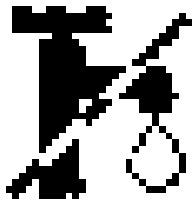


# Reeve's Double Spirea



## *Spirea cantonensis* 'Reeves'

- **Use:** An early bloomer with fragrant, white blooms emerging before the foliage on dense, arching stems. Deer resistant. Super tough! Fast growing, good for filling a space in a shrub border or naturalized hedge.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 4-5 ft. tall, 4-5 ft. wide. Prune yearly to maintain fullness and shape.
- **Hardiness:** 4 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage is bluish green, stays late into fall, it is almost an evergreen in warmer climates of the south.
- **Flower:** In mid spring, showy, delicate, white flowers are borne prolifically on upright corymbs. Prune after flowering.
