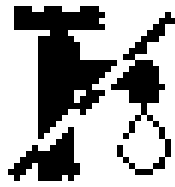


Shirobana Spirea



Spirea japonica 'Shibori'

- **Use:** An outstanding selection that offers deep rose, pink and white flowers on the same plant. Lustrous deep green foliage forms a handsome mound 2 to 3 feet tall. Wonderful for border accent, specimen or low hedges. Deer resistant. Super tough! Fast growing, good for filling a space in a shrub border or naturalized hedge.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 2-3 ft. tall, 2-3 ft. wide. Prune yearly to maintain fullness and shape.
- **Hardiness:** 4 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Bright green leaves on slender stems.
- **Flower:** Begins blooming in late spring and continues off and on through the summer. White, pink and red bloom clusters cover this dwarf, dense, mounded plant.

Fast growing, good for filling a space in a shrub border.
