

American Pillar Arborvitae



Thuja occidentalis 'American Pillar'

- **Use:** New name, same great plant! Full Speed A Hedge® 'American Pillar' arborvitae is a sport of 'Hetz Winter-green' selected for its very rapid growth rate, dense branching structure, and tall, narrow habit. It maintains this useful desirable columnar shape with minimal pruning and is an excellent specimen plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Moderate growth to 15-20ft. tall and 3 to 5 ft. wide. (After that, slower, ultimately 30'.)At a rate of 3 to 4 ft. per year, you can watch your living privacy screen become reality at a unbelievable pace. Very little, if any maintenance is needed to keep the slender columnar shape of the American Pillar.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5 -10 Shrub /Small tree.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Bright green feathery foliage.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers..
