Stately hedge or specimen tree. Can also be used in pots around the home for a few years.

Thuja occidentalis 'Emerald Green'

- **Use:** Talk about performance! Emerald Green exhibits excellent growth in any yard from Minnesota to southern Georgia and beyond. There is no need for pruning or shearing to get a full, robust tree. Ideal for matched pairs in pots for 2-3 years, or lined up as screen hedge.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Moderate growth to 12ft. tall and 4 to 5 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5 -10 Shrub /Small tree.
- **Foliage:** Holds its foliage color throughout winter. Ever-green.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers..
