

Hetz Midget Wintergreen Arborvitae



What makes the Hetz Midget Thuja Shrub a well-rounded evergreen? Well, for starters, it boasts a wonderful globe silhouette and convenient dwarf size you'll love. It's a hardy and adaptable shrub that's excellent for use in containers, rock gardens and flower beds.

Thuja occidentalis 'Hetz Midget'

- **Use:** A small evergreen shrub with a dense, naturally globe-shaped growth habit. Rich green needles are arranged in flat layered sprays. The compact form makes this a popular accent plant for mixed borders or containers. A very adaptable, tough, durable plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil. Water may not puddle around plant, and appreciates slow release fertilizer twice a year. Water if it hasn't rained in 7-10 days first 2 years. Must amend the soil if you have red clay! We recommend our **Pro Mix Soil!**
- **Growth:** *Slow growing; reaches 3 to 4 ft. tall and wide.*
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. dark green foliage. The scale-like leaves remain dark green throughout the winter.
- **Flowers:** Neither the flowers nor the fruit are ornamentally significant.
