- **Use:** Tater Tot® arborvitae is the perfect plant accessory for your landscape - its neat, rounded shape is ideal for sprucing up any space in your yard! It naturally grows as a tidy little globe of fragrant, fan-like evergreen foliage. It's somewhat tolerant of shade, too, so you can plant it just about anywhere and enjoy year-round beauty from this easy care native shrub.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil. Water may not puddle around plant, and appreciates slow release fertilizer twice a year. Water if it hasn't rained in 7-10 days first 2 years. Must amend the soil if you have red clay! We recommend our **Pro Mix Soil!**
- **Growth:** *Slow growing; reaches 1 to 2ft. tall and wide.*
- **Hardiness:** *Zone 3a-8b Shrub*
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. With swirling fans of deep green foliage, it is hardy and maintains good color all year round.
- **Flowers:** Neither the flowers nor the fruit are ornamentally significant.
