- **Use:** You'll love what Fluffy Western arborvitae does for your landscape! This unique evergreen has soft, bold foliage that emerges yellow and gives the plant a halo-like effect in the landscape. Its cheerful color persists even in winter. It naturally grows with a pyramidal shape that adds structure and shape to the garden Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Prefers moist, well drained, fertile soils. Adaptable to a range of pH. Best if pruned in late fall. Medium moisture. Often found in the wild on moist flats, slopes, banks of rivers and swamps, even found in bogs. Evergreen shrub. Fertilize in early spring by applying a slow release fertilizer specialized for evergreens. Follow the label for recommended rate of application.
- **Growth:** Stands 5-10 feet tall with a width of 3-6 feet, perfect for use as a specimen or at the corner of the home.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a-8b; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Very glossy bright yellow foliage that results in an appealing, voluminous texture in the landscape.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers..
