

Golden Spire Arborvitae



Rich golden yellow foliage provides multi-season interest. This evergreen upright shrub creates an elegant spire without pruning. Use as a focal point or plant in groups as an easy-care, colorful hedge.



Thuja plicata 'Daniellow'

- **Use:** This unique evergreen has soft, bold foliage that emerges yellow and gives the plant a halo-like effect in the landscape. Its cheerful color persists even in winter. It naturally grows with a pyramidal shape that adds structure and shape to the garden. Deer resistant. A sport from the well-known *Thuja plicata* 'Gelderland'.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Prefers moist, well drained, fertile soils. Adaptable to a range of pH. Best if pruned in late fall. Medium moisture. Often found in the wild on moist flats, slopes, banks of rivers and swamps, even found in bogs. Evergreen shrub. Fertilize in early spring by applying a slow release fertilizer specialized for evergreens. Follow the label for recommended rate of application.
- **Growth:** Moderate growth to 18 to 20 ft. tall, 4 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8b; Tall Shrub/ Tall Hedge/ Tree
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Very glossy bright yellow foliage that results in an appealing, voluminous texture in the landscape. Holds winter color well. Upright branches withstand heavy snowfall and foliage will not burn in summer heat.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers..
