'Sugar and Spice' is a hybrid of Thuja plicata, or Western Red Cedar, which is reliably cold hardy, has rich green color all year, and is deer resistant.

- <u>Use</u>: Sugar and Spice<sup>™</sup> Thuja is a narrow-growing, upright plant for small spaces. Very fine texture with green foliage on orange-brown stems. This plant is heat tolerant and a good vertical accent plant for small spaces or mixed borders. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Prefers moist, well drained, fertile soils. Adaptable to a range of pH. Best if pruned in late fall. Medium moisture. Fertilize in early spring by applying a slow release fertilizer specialized for evergreens. Follow the label for recommended rate of application.
- **Growth**: Stands 10-12 feet tall with a width of 3-3.5 feet, perfect for use as a specimen or to create privacy hedges and screens.
- Hardiness: Zone 5b-8; Shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. Soft, green, fine-textured foliage. Very disease tolerant.
- Flower: Not known for flowers...
