

# Pearlrific Viburnum



Cultivate magnificence in the garden with plentiful blooms that are fit for royalty. Beautiful pink-tinged buds open to white flowers offering a mild fragrance in the air. Even as a young plant, Pearlrific® impresses with heavy blooms in the spring. With its evergreen foliage and red fruit that ripens to black, year-round interest makes it stand out in the garden.

## *Viburnum 'Pearlrific' (hybrid 'PIVIB-I' PP #23,385)*

- **Use:** A beautiful, compact, mounding shrub with glossy, dark green foliage and large, abundant clusters of pink buds that open to lightly fragrant, white flowers in the spring. Small, red berries ripen to blue-black, providing multi-season interest. A wonderful evergreen for use as a focal point or in mixed shrub borders and foundation plantings.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun(best) to shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Tolerant of all soils and positions as long as it is not too dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 5 to 6 ft. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Deeply pleated toothed dark green leaves that turn burgundy in fall.
- **Flower:** Heavy blooms of large baseball-sized clusters of flowers open tinted green and maturing to pure white bloom in spring and give way to bright red berries that mature to black in fall.
